Most families find it more cost effective to purchase navy school pants and jackets through stores like Kmart or Target, and just purchase the uniform shirts and jumpers through FCW.

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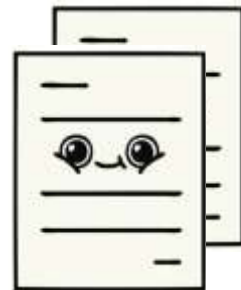
