It is important to note that the Victorian Curriculum and Assessment Authority have published a revised mathematics curriculum that we have been using this year. Your **child's mathematics report grade will now be a single aggregated score made against the standard as a whole.** Utilising this new system also means that there is no direct **comparison available to your child's previous mathematics report grade.**
