### Building Development

After a couple of years in preparation, we are extremely excited that our building redevelopment will begin these school holidays! The building development will occur in two stages. The first stage being the removal of the old Junior building and building a whole new administration wing and classrooms facing onto Narrumburn Rd. The second stage will be the removal of the Main building and building a new bank of 8 classrooms along the Clayton Road side. There will then be associated ground works to landscape the central areas.



All of our learning programs will continue as per normal throughout the building process. However, there will be some logistical changes that we need to navigate and be flexible with.
