2026 School Contributions

Information will be coming out in the coming weeks regarding the 2026 School Contribution payments.

Unfortunately, the Department of Education's School Savings Bonus initiative (SSB) will not be continuing next year, however any funds from 2025 that have not been spent will remain credited to your students' accounts and are able to be used towards camps, sports and excursion costs.

Any families that have a Health Care Card (not Medicare) with their child's name on it are eligible to apply for a CSEF (Camp, Sports and Excursions Fund) payment. Please see our office staff for forms if you think you may be eligible.

ADVERTISING AND PROMOTING TIPS TO BOOST FUNDRAISING!

ADVERTISING, PROMOTING AND COMMUNICATION IS THE KEY TO SUCCESS!

- Advertise and promote on all communication platforms – School App, Facebook, Newsletters, Teachers and Staff, Notice Boards, Assemblies, Emails and Texts
- Ensure to show images/videos of events and then prizes available on assembly and in class
- Remind everyone why they are fundraising – What is the school raising funds for? What are the funds going towards?
- Update everyone on the current amount raised and where they are sitting to reach their fundraising goal
- Get the local community involved – Community Members – even ask the Local MP to get slimed if the school reaches their target!
- Ask the sports and school captains to get involved – get them to speak on assembly or classrooms, and dress up in crew kits
- Provide the students with the Monty Colouring Page – get them excited about Monty the Monstar!
- Provide regular updates to the Teachers and Staff – Ask them to get the students not current fundraising to create a page
- Provide the MPP QR code to OSHC, parents might scan this when they drop off or collect their kids
- Get students to understand fundraising targets – raise \$10 and receive your first incentive prize, the more donations received, the more prizes you will earn!
- Ensure the Vinyl Banner is hung on the school fence
- Regularly update the school target poster provided to show the students fundraising efforts
- Partner with local businesses for matching donations or sponsorships
- Celebrate milestones publicly so students can see their progress and feel motivated
- Emphasize that every dollar raised helps and makes a difference
