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Food Allergies

Please be aware that we do have students in our school with different food allergies. There may be times when we move children away from each other when eating and have them wash their hands afterwards to maximise the safety and wellbeing of all.

Please also note that we do enforce that students do not share food (other than special birthday treats, etc. brought in) with each other.

Hats

A reminder that in line with our Sunsmart policy, that all students must be wearing a school hat (navy blue wide brimmed hat) when outside in Term 4. School hats can be ordered online through FCW, or navy blue wide brimmed hats can be purchased at Kmart for \$6 as a more cost effective alternative. Any students not wearing a hat outside in Term 4 will be required to play in undercover areas.

As with all uniform items, please ensure that hats are clearly named.

End of Term

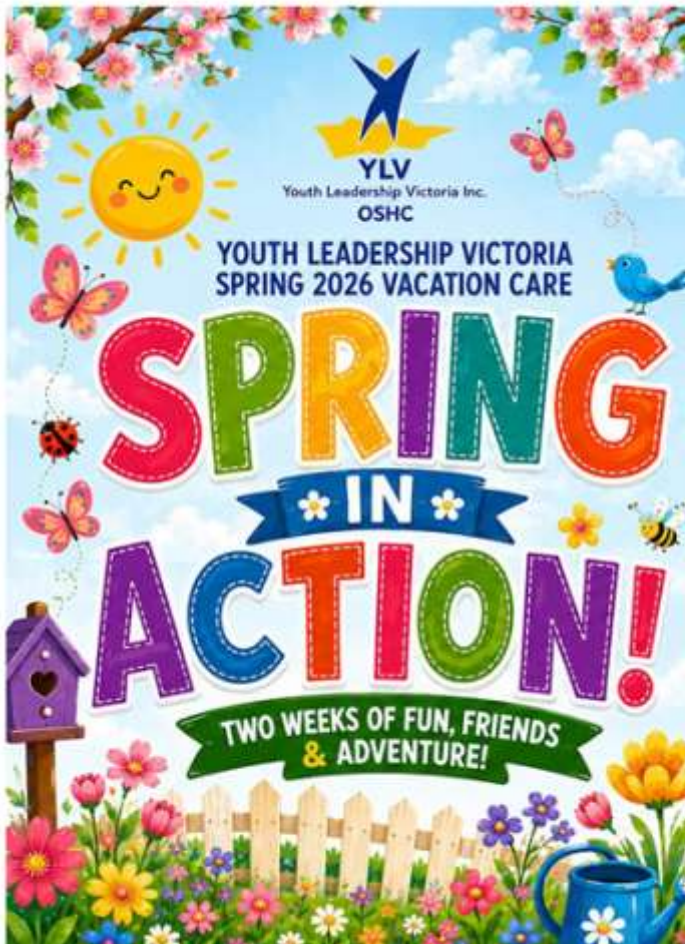
Today is the last day of term 3! Please be aware of our end of term finishing date and time, and when school resumes for Term 4.

- Have your CRN (Customer Reference Number) ready for CCS (Child Care Subsidy)
- Upload your child's medical management plan if applicable
- Important:** Once enrolled, please log on to your myGov to confirm the booking we made to activate your CCS
- The government also offers the Additional Child Care Subsidy (ACCS) for families who require more support.
 - You are an eligible grandparent receiving an income support payment
 - You are transitioning from certain income support payments to work or experiencing temporary financial hardship
 - You are caring for a child who is vulnerable or at risk of harm, abuse, or neglect
