#### School Drop Off / Pick Up

We are aware that there was Council representation present at school pick up time last week which caused concern for some families regarding parking. Council have been actively patrolling school zones and issuing parking fines for infringements. We understand that it is extremely busy surrounding the school at drop off and pick up times and ask for your patience at these times. The safety and wellbeing of our students and school community members is always our highest priority.

Please see some parking reminders / tips below:

- Please ensure that you adhere to the Kiss and Go and No Standing zones that are signed.
  - Please do not stop on the residents side of Narrumburn Rd - this is a no standing zone during drop off and pick up times.
  - Please do not turn around (U-turns) on Narrumburn Rd - it is much safer to drive around the block.
  - Please be aware that the yellow lines either side of the school crossing are strictly no standing zones.
  - Please be patient and respectful as there is currently additional traffic around.
- Some additional suggestions for parking are to park on Kitson Rd and walk down to the school, or park on Warraweena Rd (near the park) and walk up to the school.*

#### Mobile Phones

A reminder to all families and students, that in line with Department of Education guidelines, that all student mobile phones must be handed into the office in the mornings for safe keeping, where they are securely stored, and can be collected at the end of each school day.

Students should not have phones kept in their bags during the day whilst at school.

If students are wearing smart watches to school, they should be on silent with messaging and communication access turned off during the school day. If smart watches are used as a communication device during the school day, then they will be treated as a mobile device and will be required to be stored in the office for the duration of the school day.

#### Student Absences

Promoting school attendance is an ongoing priority for schools. Greater attendance gives students more exposure to learning opportunities and supports them in achieving the best possible results.

However, we do also need to ensure that if your child is unwell, that they do stay home until they have fully recovered.

Please record any absences on the Sentral Portal. If absences have not been recorded by 9:30am, an automated reminder will be sent to you, prompting you to update their absence. Absences can be notified in advance for known absence periods.
