Dear Clayton South Primary School families,

We have been very excited to welcome all students back onsite recently. The Victorian Government announced a statewide lockdown yesterday to swiftly address newly emerging cases and reduce movement in the community. Following this advice, we will move to remote and flexible learning until Thursday, I2th August inclusive. Next year, we have decided to introduce an ICT specialist class to prepare our students better to use the technology available. We want our students to be equipped and confident with their digital literacy. Unfortunately, online learning may be a new reality for our students for the next year or so. I really hope it is not.

Our **Parent Opinion Survey** has been distributed to 40 randomly selected families. So far, 25% have completed their survey responses. If you were selected, please check your emails and complete the survey when you get the chance. It provides us with valuable feedback that we use to improve our teaching and informs future decisions.

This month we will be sending out emails to confirm enrolments for **Prep 2022** and making plans to invite our future Prep students onsite for some fun learning activities. If you have not enrolled your child for next year and handed in the necessary paperwork, could you please look to finalise that with us in the next few days. You can collect an enrolment pack from the front office at any time.

August 27th will be our next Curriculum Day. Mr Hay and I will be providing information and training for our staff about the new direction we will be taking regarding writing instruction. We have made solid improvements to the way we teach reading over the past 12 months, and Mr Hay and I have recently been researching the best evidence-based practice to implement in writing. We believe we have found something that will suit our students and our context perfectly. Stay tuned!

Camp notices will be coming home this week for all families attending in November. It will be a lot of fun! The cost of the camp is \$370 and includes transport, accommodation, food, and the camp program and activities. Your note will consist of the exact figure you have remaining and a suggested payment schedule. Miss Warman's Prep Report

On Wednesday 4th August, the Preps celebrated finishing learning their single sounds. They came dressed up as our favourite character from the Milo the Monkey book. The first activity was a scavenger hunt where the preps went outside and had to find cards that had each letter of the alphabet on one side and a word on the other. The children had to read out the word and write it down on their checklist to show they had actually found it. The preps came back inside, and had several fun craft activities were waiting for them.

They could colour some of the Milo story characters, including Roxy the Rabbit and Milo the Monkey. Some students chose to colour and cut out a Leon Lion mask, and they did an excellent job staying in the lines and neatly cutting out their masks.

Some students chose to make an **origami dog** where they worked with me to carefully listen and follow instructions on folding their pieces of paper. They were then able to colour it like Daisy Dog, the Dalmatian in the Milo book. The students were also given a template to create their **colourful jelly-fish**. They learnt a cool trick to make the piece of paper curly for the jellyfish tentacles.




