Prep students have been investigating the use of MABs (Multi-base Arithmetic Blocks) throughout our Maths lessons.


Students have been exploring the significance of digits' placement in numbers, using tens and ones, further more exploring numbers beyond one hundred.


Prep students have constructed their own MAB monster creation and have found the value using the place value chart.


Through engaging activities and hands on projects, students are building solid mathematical foundations, paving the way for mathematical success beyond Prep.




