I like to think that the NAPLAN test helps to tell US as the teachers, what we have taught the students well, and what we need to place more emphasis on. I see it as a reflection on us, not on the students. We will contact families when NAPLAN results are ready to be distributed to families.

Our Kindergarten Open Day went off without a hitch and was an extremely fun day! Any chance I get to hang out with kids with the same maturity levels as me is



always enjoyable!!! We had 70 children through the school experiencing 25 minutes of STEM/Science, Art, Library and PMP. From the feedback I have received, all of the children loved it. Thank you so much to all staff who were involved and to the Year 5/6 students who did a fantastic job escorting the Kinder's from activity to activity, and assisting the children.

in books for our library so please support the school. Thank you to Felicia for organising this event every year.




